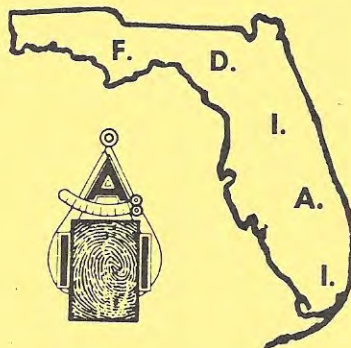

We hope this training program will be beneficial to all members enabling you to better serve the citizens of your community.

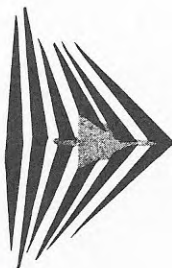


WELCOME!

Again, welcome to Fort Walton Beach and Okaloosa County; if we can be of assistance to you in any way during your stay, please do not hesitate to call.

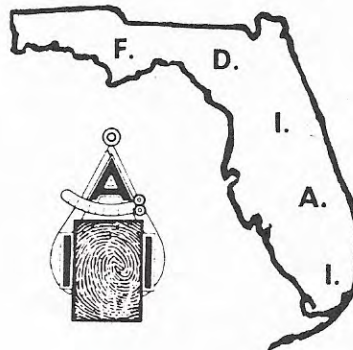

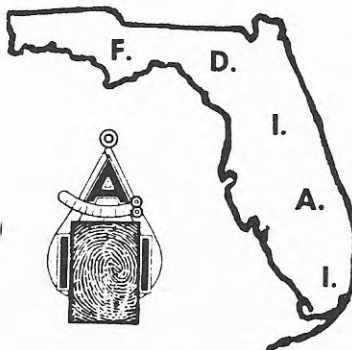
