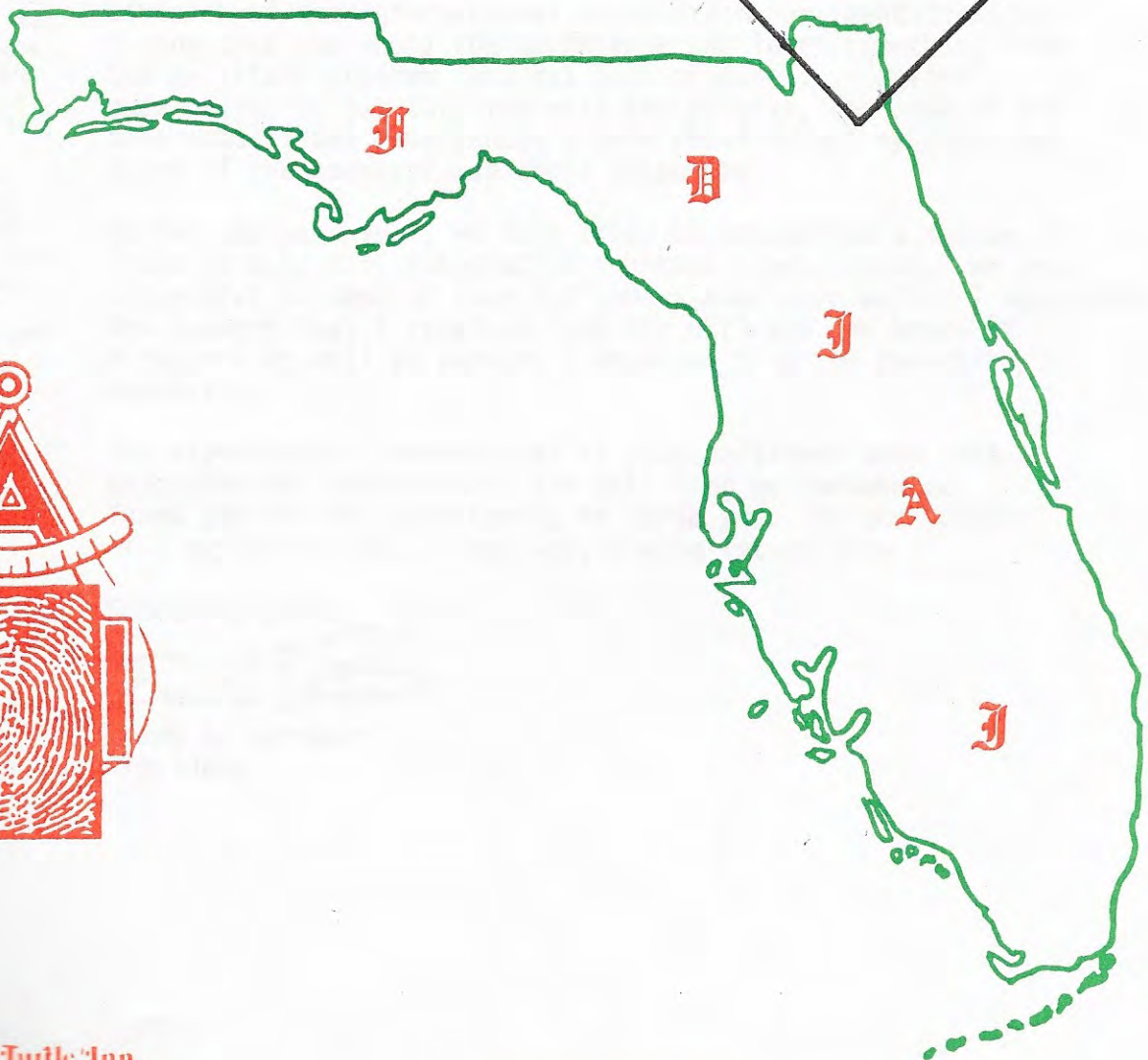
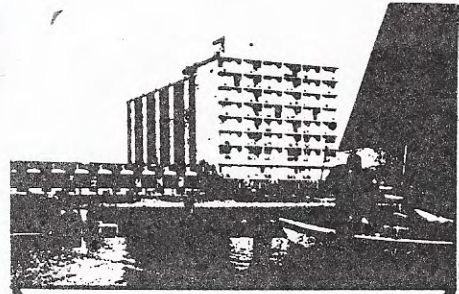

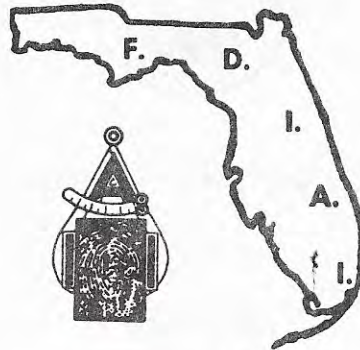

I hope you have such a great time you won't be able to resist a return visit. Please let me know if there is anything I can do to further tempt you!!

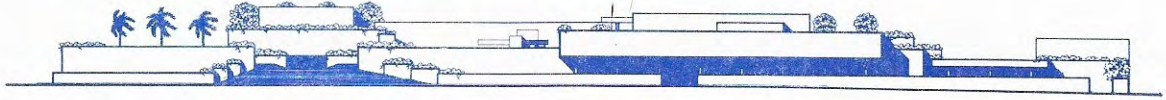

I humbly accept my responsibility of Public Trust and seek Divine guidance that I may keep inviolate the Profession of Law Enforcement.
