A UNIQUE PART OF THIS SCENE WAS MULTIPLE FLUORESCING FINGERPRINTS FOUND ON A WALL IN THE ROOM WHERE THE VICTIM WAS LOCATED. SHE WILL EXPLAIN HOW SHE HANDLED THIS AND WHAT SHE WOULD DO DIFFERENTLY NOW AFTER GAINING MORE EXPERIENCE IN THE FIELD. WHILE THE FLUORESCING FINGERPRINTS PLAYED A BIG ROLE IN THIS CASE, IT WAS JUST ONE SMALL PIECE OF EVIDENCE IN A CASE THAT INVOLVED MULTIPLE CSIs, MULTIPLE CRIME SCENES, AND MULTIPLE SCENE RESPONSES.
